A MESSAGE *from* YOUR CHAIRMAN

This year we will have two sources for questions:

- 1) In-person shareholders will be selected randomly to ask whatever they wish.
- 2) Becky Quick, of CNBC, will curate questions from non-attending shareholders and use those she believes will have the widest interest. Questions can be submitted to Becky at berkshirequestions@cnbc.com. Becky has the discretion to ask a follow-up if she feels we have not been sufficiently responsive to the question she has selected.

We will not have a movie this year but rather will convene a bit earlier at 8am I will make a few introductory remarks, and we will promptly get to the Q&A, alternating questions between Becky and the audience.

Greg and Ajit will join me in answering questions and we will take a half-hour break at 10:30am When we reconvene at 11am, only Greg will join me on stage. This year we will disband at 1pm but stay open for shopping in the exhibit area until 4pm.

Ajit handles insurance operations and Greg is in charge of all other operations. If questions are asked that are relevant to either of these areas, Becky or the on-premise questioner will get an answer from Ajit or Greg.

The three of us will not get so much as a clue about the questions to be asked. We know you and Becky will pick some tough ones and that's the way we like it.

There will be a 7:45am drawing at each of the 11 microphone locations to select shareholders who wish to ask "audience" questions.

- Ask your question promptly — speak loud & clear.
- Do not ask more than one question or attempt to “bundle” several questions together.
- Do not ask what we are buying or selling. Even if the information is public, we do not discuss how we arrive at our decisions. We also will not discuss politics. Any other subjects are fair game.

Boxed Lunch Vouchers can be redeemed at any Express Lunch Distribution location on Saturday, May 3 only. The variety of boxed lunch options will be based on availability per distribution location.

Americans With Disabilities Act

The CHI Health Center Omaha is a public facility subject to Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA). The current exhibition on display, *War Games*, explores how living artist and Holocaust survivor, Samuel Bak relates his childhood experiences - from his direct renderings of the Holocaust in his watercolors from 1945 to 1948 to a selection of his contemporary paintings and drawings. Through the presentation of toys and game pieces, Bak draws our attention to the realities of childhoods spent in zones of conflict and how children are pawns used by warring parties. The exhibition will dedicate one room to historic and contemporary instances of children human rights violations. These works represent his fears for children whose lives and futures are destroyed by war and the escalation of violence in the Middle East. As much as he mourns this age of destruction, he also depicts his unending belief in humanity's ability to mend and his hope that somehow peace and reason will triumph.
