Welcome to Omaha. We are excited you are joining us for our Owners' Day and our formal Annual Meeting of Berkshire Shareholders.

We will start our time together on Saturday at 8:30 a.m., with our Business Update. Following that, we will move into our Q&A Sessions - the first at 9:30 a.m. with Ajit and me; and the second at 11:45 a.m. (after we reconvene from a 60-minute break) where I will be joined by Katie Farmer of BNSF and Adam Johnson, who leads NetJets and serves as president of our consumer products, service, and retailing businesses.

As in years past, we will have two sources for questions: 1) in-person shareholders will be selected randomly and can ask anything they want; and 2) Becky Quick of CNBC will select questions from non-attending shareholders and use those she believes will have the widest interest. Questions can be submitted to Becky at [berkshirequestions@cnbc.com](mailto:berkshirequestions@cnbc.com). Becky has the discretion to ask a follow-up if she feels we have not been sufficiently responsive to her question, and neither Ajit, Katie, Adam nor I will have any preview of her questions.

We will recess at 1:00 p.m., but the exhibit area will remain open for shopping until 4:00 p.m.

There will be an 8:15 a.m. drawing at each of the 10 microphone locations for those shareholders wishing to ask questions themselves.

I look forward to our time together.

## Meeting Credentials

Boxed Lunch Vouchers are limited and available for advance purchase starting at 12pm on Friday, May 1 until the 1pm recess on Saturday, May 2. This allows shareholders the ability to pre-purchase their voucher so you can redeem them on Saturday. Boxed Lunch Vouchers can be redeemed at any Express Lunch Distribution location on Saturday, May 2 only. The variety of boxed lunch options will be based on availability per distribution location.

## **Americans With Disabilities Act**

The CHI Health Center Omaha is a public facility subject to Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
